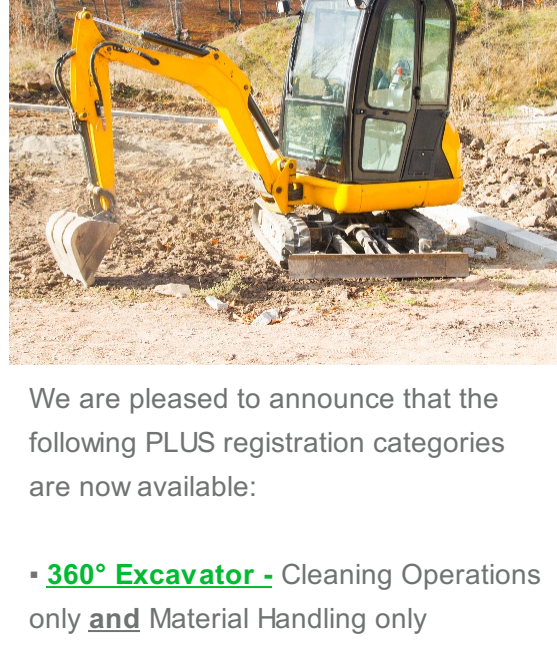
20 years of National Water Hygiene

PLUS Scheme - new registration categories

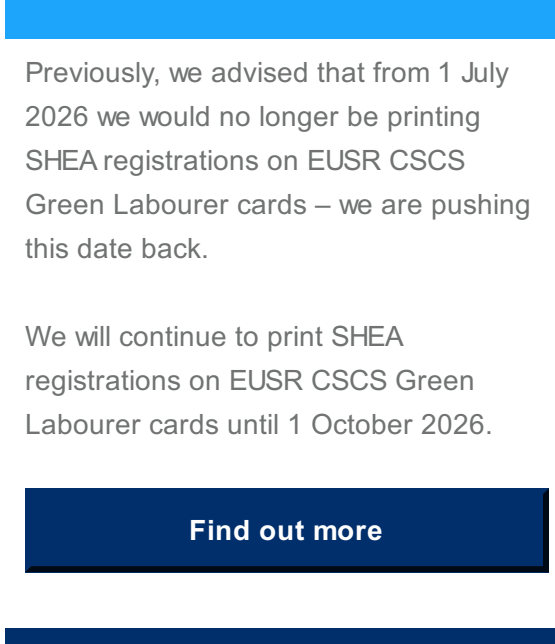


We are pleased to announce that the following PLUS registration categories are now available:

Important update regarding EUSR CSCS Card changes

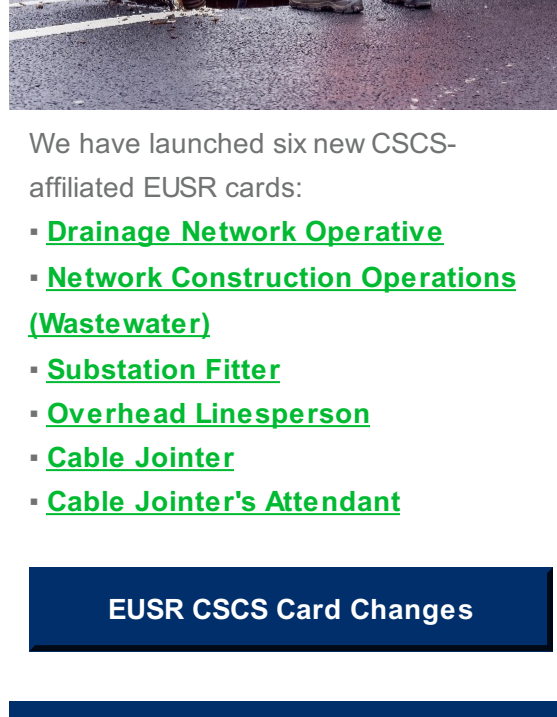


Previously, we advised that from 1 July 2026 we would no longer be printing SHEA registrations on EUSR CSCS Green Labourer cards – we are pushing this date back.

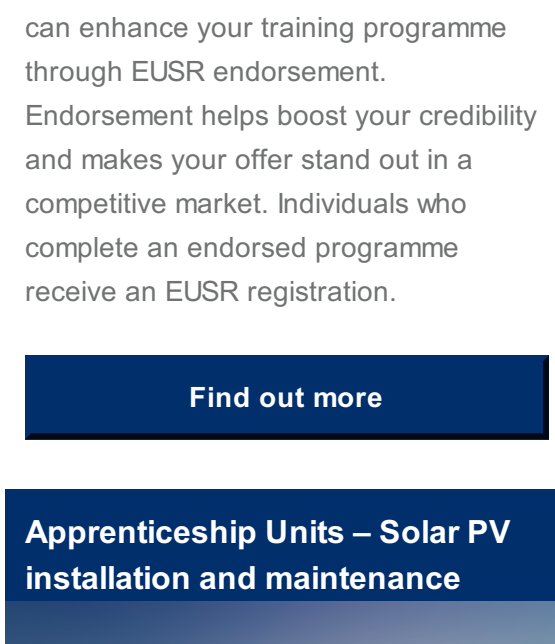

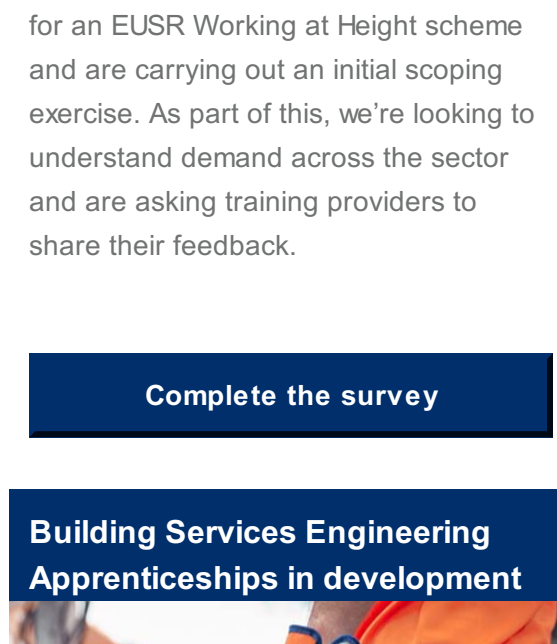
Endorsed Training Programmes

Apprenticeship Units – Solar PV installation and maintenance

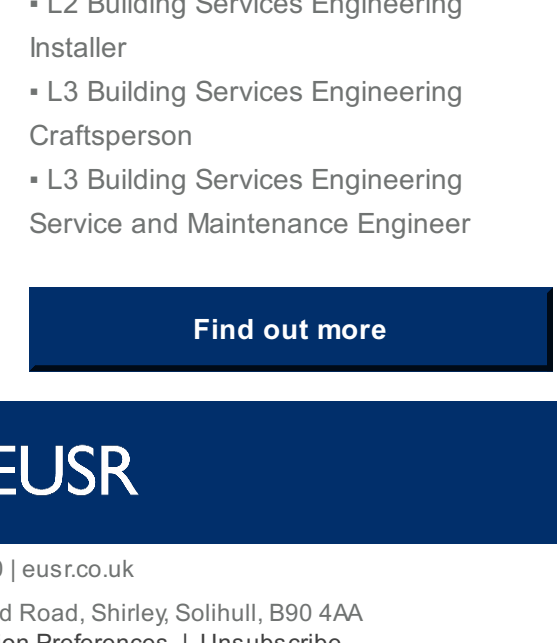


Apprenticeship Units are the latest Government initiative to enable apprenticeship levy funding to be used to meet other skills demands.
