Key Dates to Remember

30 September 2026: Final day to deliver SHEA (2023/24)

SHEA (2023/24) programmes can be delivered until 30 September 2026. After this date, SHEA (2026) will be the only SHEA programme available for delivery.

1 October 2026: New EUSR CSCS card arrangements come into effect

From 1 October 2026:

- EUSR SHEA registrations will no longer be issued with the CSCS logo.
 - SHEA remains the mandatory health and safety requirement for all EUSR CSCS cards.
- EUSR remains the CSCS Alliance Partner for the utilities sector.
- Individuals can apply for an EUSR CSCS card that matches their role and responsibilities.
- Existing EUSR SHEA registrations issued with the CSCS logo will remain valid until their expiry date.

13 November 2026: Deadline to submit SHEA (2023/24) results

Results for SHEA (2023/24) courses delivered before 1 October 2026 must be submitted through QuartzWeb by 13 November 2026.

16 November 2026: Only SHEA (2026) batches will be processed.

Combined Claims

Combined Claims is now available in QuartzWeb, making it easier to apply for EUSR CSCS cards for multiple learners at the same time.

- The feature is optional and provides a quicker way to submit card applications after delivering eligible SHEA programmes.
- Individual applications can still be made through the online shop.
- If you use Combined Claims, it is important to **[select the correct programme and card combination](#)**.

SHEA remains a requirement for EUSR CSCS Cards

As the sector transitions to the new EUSR CSCS card arrangements, we are aware of some confusion about whether SHEA is still required.

SHEA remains the mandatory health and safety training required when applying for EUSR CSCS cards.

The changes taking effect from 1 October 2026 relate to how CSCS cards are issued. They do not change the requirement to complete SHEA training.

New EUSR CSCS Card coming soon

We will launch the Experienced Worker Card for Water Mains Commissioning on 24 September 2026.
